



## ALLCOM CALLING CARD user guide.

In the bag you find two cards, a white and a coloured. On both of them, in the top-right corner you can see the available amount in EUR.

On the colour, laminated card in the white area (in the box on the white card) you find the serial number of the card and above that the call-up number.

After calling that number, the machine asks for your PIN code. You can find it on the back of the white card under the silver (abradeable) stripe.

After entering the PIN code the machine tells you your account and asks you to dial the number you wanted to call. The menu is English by default. (German, Chinese, and Hungarian can also be set)

After that you call the dialled number via **ALLCOM'S** network, the price of the call will be taken away from your account. Your account is available for one year after buying or last charging it.

The following extra services are available on the cards:

- Language selection: \*1 Hungarian, \*2 English, \*3 German, \*4 Chinese, \*5 French, \*6 Arabic
- Saving your number (no PIN code required for the calls): \*7
- Deleting your number (PIN code required again): \*8
- Charging your card (from another card): \*9
- Start new call: ##
- Dialling last number: \*#
- Asking for your actual account: \*\*
